Local Making A Plan (MAP) Teams are made up of families, child-serving systems and organizations that work with families. The goal of MAP Teams is to help children who are risk for out-of-home placements (acute psychiatric hospitals, psychiatric residential treatment facilities or detention) to stay at home with their families.
